- Manages improvement/compliance projects with full P&A and reporting responsibility, and actively coaches the project teams in LEAN project management routines.
- Supports the projects of Department Managers and SME's with active participation and methodological support.
- Owns and improves the project masterplan, loss elimination masterplan and meeting structure of the Packaging Site.
- Maps and keeps updated the key processes of the Budapest Packaging Site's operations. Assess current state and works out/design improvement proposals. Updates the process descriptions and other documents (SOP'S, WI's, etc.)
